5. Read the articles "Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002: an overview" and "Justices, 5-4, Reject Corporate Spending Limit." Go back to the graphs for your selected interest group. What changes do you see after McCain-Feingold? After the Citizens United v. FEC case? Which of these do you see as the better step for ensuring that the constitutional principle of Popular Sovereignty is maintained? Why?
