1. Surah XXVII 61-65 addresses the Muslim belief in the nature of god. Explain how this view is different from that of Christianity and pre-Islamic religions of the Arabian peninsula.

2. Beginning on page 351 there are examples of the prescriptions of Islam. Find examples of five different things that a Muslim is charged to do in life.

3. Compare the Muslim prescriptions with those of Judaism. Describe at least two similarities and differences. (It might be helpful to refer to pages 264 through 268.)
