

Things to look for

- Always paraphrase [unless it's a quote by an historic figure]
- Don't ever copy and paste
- In your bibliography, NOTHING should lack a publisher unless it's a personal interview
- Print bib from Msword or Googledocs [Noodletools export]
- Citations MUST be correct or information cited cannot be considered

"Dominican Republic." *World History: The Modern Era*. ABC-CLIO, 2014. Web. 18 Mar. 2014.

Your citation would be: ("Dominican Republic")

If it looks like this:

Perlez, Jane. "Chinese Oil Rig Near Vietnam to Be Moved." *The New York Times*. The New York Times, 15 July 2014. Web. 24 Sept. 2014.

Your citation would be: (Perlez)

Things to look for

- Don't "run out of steam" [many projects have excellent research in first sections, then become inadequate]
- Get help if you can't find sources for information
- Read rubric carefully and reread before final edit
- Don't use words unless you know what they mean ["nationalize"]
- Remember, YOU ARE TELLING A STORY... IT MUST BE COMPLETE
