

U.S. History World War II Timeline Instructions

You will create a timeline of World War II events during this unit of study. Some of these events are present on the list of dates you have been provided with, and some are not. For dates not available on the list of dates, you should add them to your timeline as you read chapters 24 and 25. Be sure to create a timeline to scale, so that each year is the same length. You should include 1938 through 1945. Include the dates of the following events:
